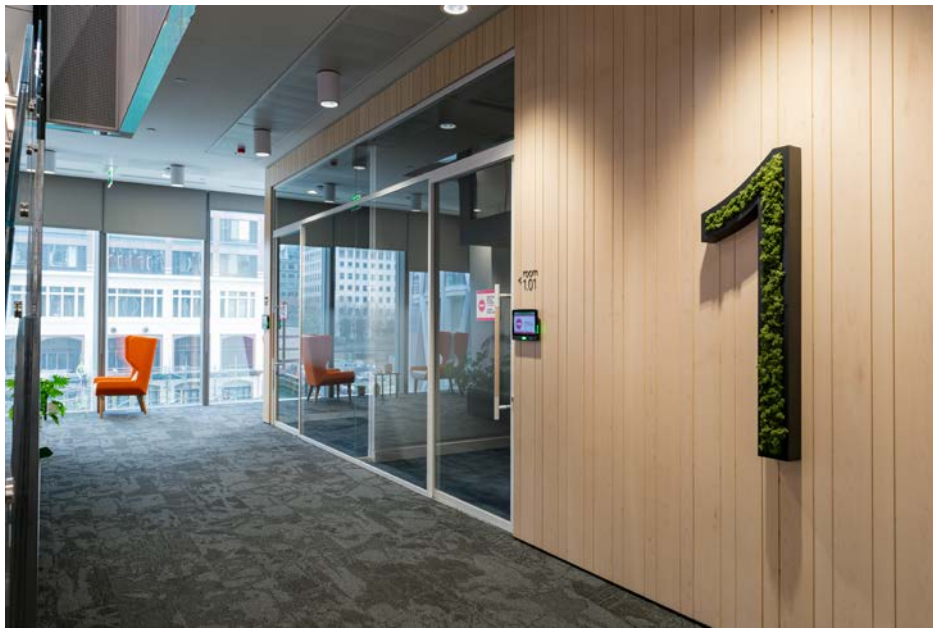
xsign worked with architects tp bennett on the internal signage scheme for French bank, Société Générale, at One Bank Street, Canary Wharf.

The feature signs and wayfinding office signs are spread across several floors of the building. The signage that features throughout is a combination of metal laser cut and matt acrylic.

To the room doors, we have supplied cut letters with a bronze RAL colour match finish, to help the scheme to blend with the client's colour palette.

Additional signage features include for the facilities and services using cut letters and rail mounting.

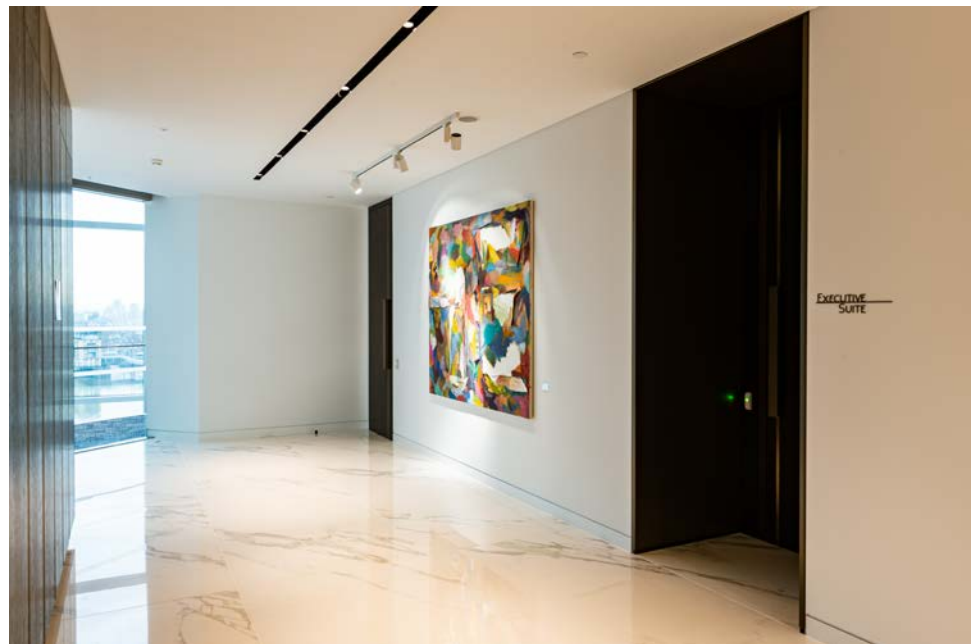




Floor level numbers supplied across 7 floors provide a visual wayfinding reference. On floors 1-4, we have provided numbers with preserved moss for an interesting and unique effect.

On floors 6 and 7, we have provided wall mounted cut numerals.

On the client levels, the signage scheme uses a high quality anodised aluminium, with bronze paint finish to help the signage to blend with other features.



The dining rooms, meeting rooms and restaurant signs feature consistent lettering, spacing and mounting.
