xsign were appointed by BAM Construction and Architect, Pozzoni, to provide an internal and external signage scheme at Chorlton High School in Manchester.

Internally, our signage scheme features our Jigsaw and Puzzle patented product set, alongside graphics and iconography to aid wayfinding and navigation in the modern education facility.

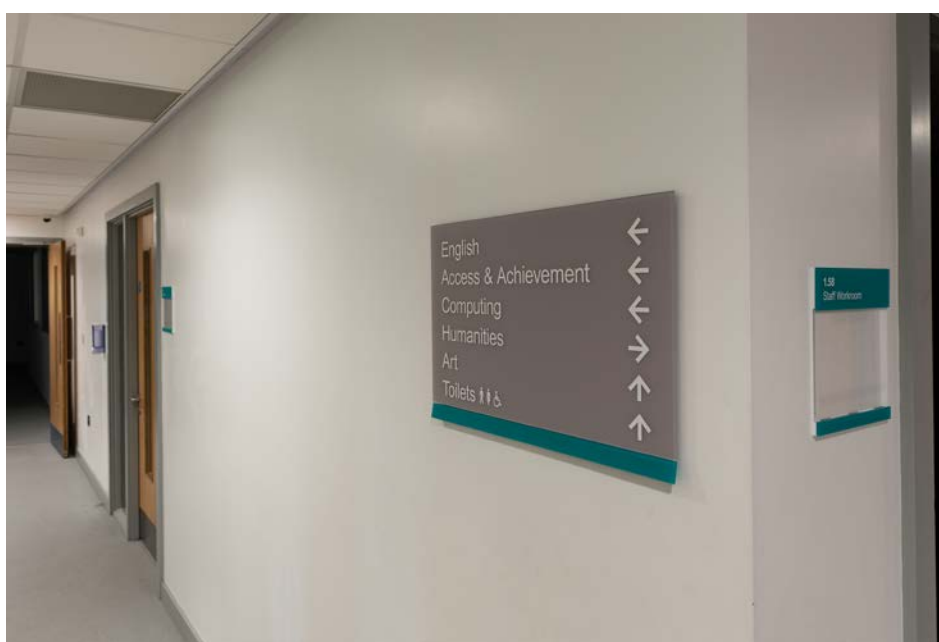
Externally, we have designed, manufactured and installed a series of cut stainless steel letters that depict the school branding and provide wayfinding reference at the entrance to the building.





The external CHS logo features a 3mm aluminium logo, coated to match the colour requirements of the scheme. The logo is profile cut and mounted to the external brickwork with suitable wall anchors and adhesive.

The Jigsaw system allows for the easy changing of panels. 3mm frosted acrylic material with high resolution direct digital print helps provide excellent legibility for wayfinding.



3mm frosted acrylic lettering has been assigned to the floor levels to provide wayfinding across the Ground floor, 1st floor and 2nd floor, fixed to the wall with a secure tape.

To the entrance of the building, we provided 3mm coated aluminium lettering with automotive grade paint to provide longevity. The sign is mounted to the brickwork with fixings.



Our Puzzle sign system allows for the easy changing of paper inserts so that information about the room can be displayed and easily swapped and changed.

We also supplied iconography around the school to depict the main facilities. We've supplied 3mm frosted acrylic door signs with grey band colour, and laser cut with a high polish finish.
