xsign were appointed to design, manufacture and install the signage scheme at 11 and 12 Wellington Place for clients Wates and MEPC, who provide high quality office space for businesses and organisations in Leeds.

The external signage comprises illuminated double sided retail blade projecting signs, bronze coloured stencil spray painted signage at the entrance to the car park and bespoke glazing manifestations.

Internally, we have supplied illuminated halo numerals in the lift lobbies, 3mm aluminium cut signage to signal toilets and other facilities, self-adhesive full colour digitally printed wall graphics in the stairwells, plot cut vinyl graphics to indicate EV charging points, aluminium built up letters to signify the bike store and internal graphic manifestations to glazing.





In the car park, we have supplied plot cut white vinyl graphics to floor and wall concrete paint to denote the EV charging points.

In the reception area, we've provided a full colour digital print to sliding doors on clear white perimeter lines to match the RAL branding colours, with a 70% transparency.



Lift lobbies feature aluminium built up letters and numerals to denote the floor level. We've supplied 40mm deep returns, painted to match the branded colours.

The stairwells feature full colour digitally printed vinyl graphics with heat bonding to the substrate.



The internal iconography for key facilities such as toilets and bin stores is 3mm aluminium cut to shape, fitted with strong tape.

We've supplied plot cut reverse applied frosted window manifestations throughout the building to provide warning of glass panes, as well as branding to the spaces.
