



The Watchfactory and Clockwork Court

- Case Study

The Watchfactory and Clockwork Court provide supported living accommodation for its residents in Prescot, Liverpool.

xsign provided an internal and external signage scheme to provide branding to the space and wayfinding around key facilities.

Across the two buildings we've manufactured 3mm thick frosted acrylic wayfinding directory panels with 3D digitally printed tactile braille text, a range of 3mm general door signs and apartment signs, and a broad range of stencil cut glazing manifestations, digitally printed coated textile wall graphics and frosted acrylic floor level indicators.





Apartment directory signs provide wayfinding around the two buildings. 3D digitally printed tactile and braille text printed at high resolution provides excellent legibility and accessibility.

In the stairwells we've manufactured and fitted 3mm frosted acrylic floor level indicators featuring digitally printed artwork.



Corridors feature wayfinding directory boards with a high polish edge detail and digitally printed adhesion for a tamper proof finish.

The external signage features a 2mm fabricated aluminium tray with 30m deep returns seamlessly welded, and high grade automotive paint.



We've provided stencil cut adhesive vinyl manifestations applied to the reverse of the glazing in a clear dusted crystal finish.
