

DOLPHIN SQUARE

Dolphin Square, London - Case Study

xsign delivered the internal and external signage for Dolphin Square, a high-end mixed-use development in London redeveloped by Galliford Try.

Externally, halo-illuminated bronze hairline stainless steel letters were installed on the Chichester Street façade, mounted on opal acrylic carriers and lit at 2700K.

Internally, the scheme includes Lucite door and directional signs, fixed to both glazed and solid surfaces using secure tape fixings. Aeonik typography was used consistently across meeting rooms, call booths, and amenities to help create a high quality internal scheme.

In the reception and gym areas, illuminated stainless steel identity signs with 50mm deep returns were installed, backlit at 3000K for a warm tone. All signage was coordinated with the contractor to suit tiled walls, timber panels, and joinery.





The illuminated “Dolphin Square” sign creates a strong focal point behind the front desk. Its elevated placement and warm lighting unify the entrance area and the upper-level coworking space.

The primary “Dolphin Square” identity sign features halo-illuminated bronze-finished built-up letters. Installed directly onto the stone façade, the sign delivers clear branding visible from street level.



A double-sided powder-coated aluminium panel provides essential exterior navigation, directing visitors to reception, gardens, and the fitness club. Text is rendered in Aeonik and painted to match RAL 7013.

Halo-illuminated built-up stainless steel letters with a bronze hairline finish form the centrepiece of the reception space. Mounted to a tiled backdrop, the warm 3000K glow adds subtle sophistication.



Flush-mounted bronze-painted Lucite letters provide clear wayfinding to the lift and security office. Installed with VHB tape, the signage contrasts against a light wall finish while aligning with the interior palette.

Compact directional signage in bronze-finished Lucite sits beneath emergency lighting, maintaining visual clarity in a busy corridor. Fixed using VHB tape, the minimal design ensures clean integration.
